


and talked to us for a while about school and learning, and we all had a chance to explore our new books. It was very exciting and we are very grateful for the gift. These atlases will be well used and well loved.

The sun was shining and it was great to see that a number of our students had brought their instruments from home and were demonstrating their musical talents to the masses.












SQUIGGLE - We're Opening! July School Holiday's: 6th - 17th July 2020
