NZEI Paid Union Meetings

As you will be aware, the Primary Teachers' Union (NZEI) has been negotiating with the government for quite some time now on better conditions for optimal learning in our schools. The NZEI will be hosting paid union meetings throughout the area over next week to discuss the latest offer from the government. As a school community, we are entirely behind

the NZEI and its actions for fighting for a better class of education for our kids - one that works for ALL and one we can be proud of. We are also here to support our community of whānau and caregivers and realise that as much as we support industrial action (one of the only tools in the toolbox), we want to make this process as less disruptive as we can. We have organised it so that teachers will attend meetings over two days next week with half going in the afternoon of Tuesday 19th and half going on Wednesday 20th. This will mean that school will remain open for learners over the union meeting times. Classroom programmes will run as normal until lunchtime on both days, but to release teachers in the afternoons, classes will be combined with their Tuakana-Teina Class (buddy classes).
