#### **NZEI / PPTA Industrial Action**

Today you would have received a notice from our Board of Trustees confirming that they have been notified by the NZEI of a national strike on Wednesday 29 May. Due to the number of staff involved in this and the affect on complying with health and safety requirements, the Board has elected to close the school for instruction on this day. This means that you will need to find alternative plans for your children on this day.

This is an unprecedented move from both the primary teachers' union (NZEI) and the secondary (PPTA) to come together in action in the hopes of addressing the issues that prevent New Zealand schools operating at optimum levels for our children. As a school we realise that the decision to strike is an inconvenience to so many - but it's important to remember what is at stake here. New Zealand children are deserving of a world class education system where we are able to meet and exceed the needs of ALL learners. A reminder of the main points the teachers' unions are campaigning for:

- 1. A better support structure in the areas of special education and complex behaviour needs. How are schools supposed to maintain high teaching standards when this area is under-resourced?
- 2. There is a national teacher shortage and this needs to be addressed now.
- 3. We need to retain and attract quality professionals into the teaching workforce. We need to make teaching a rewarding profession.
- 4. There needs to be time to teach and lead more resourcing needs to be provided to support this.

The NZEI decision to strike again is serious - but so is the future of our education system. Let's join together as a school community as we seek to make the schools of Aotearoa world-class for all our tamariki!

If you would like to support us on this journey, how about sending an email of support to our local MPs or better yet, Mr Hipkins? All their contact details are available on the Labour Party website. On the strike day, all teachers from around Hamilton with be gathering at the band rotunda at 11.30am to march down Victoria Street - you'd be welcome to show your support there too.



Due to the Teachers Strike day next Wednesday the 29<sup>th</sup> of May, **YMCA** Hamilton will **NOT** be operating before school care, after school care or alternative programmes on this day.

# Hockey


